



Sleeping Bag Safari Guidelines

Please give to everyone attending the overnight program.

Tentative Schedule

Optional 6:15-6:45 p.m.	Dinner (Gold package only) (Must be ordered 3 weeks prior to safari)
6:45-7:00 p.m.	Meet Safari Leaders at Main Gate to begin your night! – Please arrive by 6:45pm .
7:00-7:45 p.m.	Move vehicles onto Zoo property (The fewer vehicles, the better). Orientation and activities
7:45-9:15 p.m.	Night hike
9:15-10:00 p.m.	Zoo related games and activities.
10:00pm-12:00 a.m.	Inside building for the night.
6:00 a.m.	Wake up call.
6:00-7:15 a.m.	Clean building, pack gear, load gear into vehicles, move cars to main parking area.
Optional 7:00-7:30 a.m.	Breakfast packages available for purchase (Must be ordered 3 weeks prior to overnight!)
7:15- 9:00 a.m.	Morning hike.
9:00 a.m.	End of program. You are welcome to stay the remainder of the day at the Zoo and Aquarium.

- Your safari leaders will arrive at the front gate at 6:45pm to greet you. If you arrive after 7:00 pm, you will not be allowed admission into the zoo. Please unload your gear to ease admission. If you are signed up for the GOLD package, please be at the zoo by 6:00pm.
- Things to bring:
 - o Sleeping bag, pillow, air mattress, or cot. All indoor locations have electricity available.
 - Minimal personal gear. The Aquarium may be kept cooler than other buildings due to the temperature requirements of the aquatic animals. There are no showers.
 - o Weather-appropriate clothing, good shoes for hiking.
 - o Optional short DVD to watch after night hike. (We have a small selection available)
 - o Money for t-shirts (\$15), plush animal (\$10) & patches (\$2) if you do not use pre-order form.
 - o The Lied Jungle, Desert Dome, Prairie Dog Meadow, Bear Canyon, and Sea Lion Pavilion require you to provide your own 2-4 person pop-up tents. (Some are available for rental pre-order required)
- No outside food or drinks are permitted during the Sleeping Bag Safaris Program. There are dinner, snack, breakfast, and drink packages available for purchase.
- Please remember that you are responsible for carrying everything you bring to your overnight location. The OHDZA
 does not provide transportation or wagons to your building. You may bring your own wagons, etc. to carry your gear
 if needed.
- All participants must participate in the hike and be attended by OHDZA staff at all times when out of the building. If you will need a wheelchair please notify the OHDZA before your safari.
- Alcohol is not allowed on OHDZA grounds.
- There can be no children under the age of 4 in attendance at overnights.
- There are no pets or other outside animals allowed on zoo grounds.
- The zoo is a tobacco-free facility. There is NO SMOKING ALLOWED on OHDZA grounds.
- All adults are responsible for following OHDZA rules and enforcing rules with the children.
